## Miller Analogies Test (MAT)

### MILLER ANALOGIES TEST (MAT)

The Miller Analogies Test (MAT) is a high-level test of analytical ability that requires the solution of problems stated as analogies. The MAT consists of 120 partial analogies that are to be completed in 60 minutes. The test measures your ability to recognize relationships between ideas, your fluency in the English language, and your general knowledge of the humanities, natural sciences, mathematics, and social sciences.

### TESTING INFORMATION

The Candidate Information Booklet contains instructions for candidates taking the MAT and an explanation of what happens after the test. It includes information about interpreting scores and ordering additional Official Transcripts, as well as other fees and special services. Each candidate must present two forms of identification (ID). IDs are only valid if they are unexpired. The primary form of ID must be government-issued and contain both the candidate's photograph and signature; they include: Driver's license, Government-issued identification card or passport.

Valid forms of secondary ID include: Credit card (with or without a photograph), Library card, Utility bill with the candidate's name and address appearing exactly the same as on the primary form of ID.

### TESTING CENTER

Dickinson State University works accommodate to individuals wishing to take the MAT. It is not necessary to be enrolled at DSU to test at DSU. The DSU Testing Center is located in the lower level of Stoxen Library (See the Campus Map below), and is open Monday-Friday, 1:00pm-4:30pm.
