

## Calculating GPA

### Honor Points

University grades are reported in letter symbols, each carrying a value in honor points per credit hour.  
Honor Point Scale:

A = 4 points

B = 3 points

C = 2 points

D = 1 point

F = 0 points

Withdraw, Incomplete, Satisfactory, Unsatisfactory, and Audit are also 0 points.

### GPA Points

Take the honor points and multiply by the number of credits for the course.

Examples:

- ART 281 is worth 3 credits. Let's say you receive an "A" in the course. Multiply 3 (# of credits) by 4 (# of honor points for getting an "A"). That's a total of 12 points earned toward your GPA.
- ENGL 110 is worth 3 credits. Let's say you receive a "C" in the class. Multiply 3 (# of credits) by 2 (# of honor points for getting a "C"). That's a total of 6 points earned toward your GPA.
- HPER 100 is worth 2 credits. Let's say you received a "D" for the course. 2 (credits) x 1 (honor points) = 2 GPA points

### Semester GPA

Add up the number of **honor points** you earned for the semester and divide them by the number of **credits you attempted** for the semester to find your semester GPA.

Example:

Class	# Cr	Grade	GPA Points
BIOL 150	4	B	4x3 = 12
BIOL 150L	1	A	1x4 = 4
ENGL 110	3	B	3x3 = 9
HIST 103	3	A	3x4 = 12
PSYC 111	3	C	3x2 = 6
UNIV 100	1	A	1x4 = 4

Total # Points Earned: 47

Total # Credits Attempted: 15

Semester GPA =  $47 \div 15 = 3.1$

### Cumulative GPA

Add up the number of **honor points** you earned EACH semester and divide them by the number of **credits you attempted** for EACH semester to find your **Cumulative** GPA.
