Scholarships:

- Bank of North Dakota: The <u>Bank of North Dakota</u> provides financial assistance to pay for up to two dual credit courses per school year if you meet the following qualifications:
 - Are a current sophomore, junior or senior attending a North Dakota high school,
 - Receive authorization from your high school to take the approved dual credit course,
 - Qualify for free or reduced price lunch, and
 - o Submit an application for assistance to BND during the course enrollment process.

- Early Entry Scholarship:
 - Must have a cumulative 3.0 GPA or receive administrative referral to be eligible
 - To be eligible to renew these scholarships each semester, students must receive a C or better in DSU courses they have previously completed
 - DSUHF will provide a scholarship for \$80 per credit for up to three credits per class to qualified students. Funds are limited.
 - Stark county high school student
 - Apply to DSU Early Entry Program. No additional scholarship application needed.
 - Must complete and return scholarship packet provided by the DSU Heritage Foundation.
- DPS Scholarship:
 - Must enroll in the sections designated for DHS Early Entry
 - o Must have a cumulative 3.0 GPA or receive administrative referral to be eligible
