- Bank of North Dakota: The <u>Bank of North Dakota</u> provides financial assistance to pay for up to two dual credit courses per school year if you meet the following qualifications:
  - Are a current sophomore, junior or senior attending a North Dakota high school,
  - Receive authorization from your high school to take the approved dual credit course,
  - o Qualify for free or reduced price lunch, and
  - o Submit an application for assistance to BND during the course enrollment process.

- High Fliers Scholarship:
  - o Are a current sophomore, junior, or senior attending high school.
