Scholarships:

- Bank of North Dakota: The [Bank of North Dakota](#) provides financial assistance to pay for up to two dual credit courses per school year if you meet the following qualifications:
 - Are a current sophomore, junior or senior attending a North Dakota high school,
 - Receive authorization from your high school to take the approved dual credit course,
 - Qualify for free or reduced price lunch, and
 - Submit an application for assistance to BND during the course enrollment process.

- High Fliers Scholarship:
 - Are a current sophomore, junior, or senior attending high school.
 - Minimum high school GPA of 3.0.
 - Reduces the cost of attendance to approximately \$86 per credit to qualified students. Funds are limited.
 - Renewable with a minimum of 3.0 GPA in DSU coursework.
 - Apply to DSU Early Entry Program. No additional scholarship application needed.
 - Submit a copy of high school transcript to be considered.
